Contest Rules:

ι All entries must incorporate the 2023 Fire Prevention Week theme. This year's theme is:

"Cooking Safety Starts With You"

- Entries may be submitted on poster board or paper. Maximum size 22" x 28". Any color is acceptable. NO 3-D posters (flat only.) Posters must be able to be hung on the wall without any material falling off.
- Each entry **MUST** have the <u>student's full name</u>, <u>grade</u>, <u>school name</u>, and <u>teacher's name</u> on the back of the poster.
 - Deadline for entries is Friday, October 6th, 2023.
- Preliminary judging will be held on **October 6th**. Ribbons will be distributed for first place, second place, and Honorable Mention ribbon will be awarded in each grade in each school. The school with the most participation will receive a traveling trophy for the year. Judging is done by members of the Lincolnshire-Riverwoods Fire Department.
- Trophies will be awarded to winners at each grade level for all posters entered. The poster that best depicts this year's theme will receive the grand prize trophy. The grand prize winner will be announced on a later date TBD, after judging has been completed.
- The grand champion will move on to the regional championship round for an overall winner with neighboring Fire Departments.
 - Posters will be returned to the schools and can be given back to the students on October 31st.
- Ideas from parents are welcome, but all work should come from the children
