Lincolnshire-Riverwoods Fire Protection District Hosts Open Houses to Discuss Proposed Fire Station

WHAT: [The Lincolnshire-Riverwoods Fire Protection District \(LRFD\)](#) is hosting open houses so residents can ask questions and share feedback on the referendum.

On Tuesday, April 1, 2025, the community will vote on the Lincolnshire-Riverwoods Fire Protection District (LRFD) bond referendum to raise \$25 million to build a strategically located fire station at 3750 Deerfield Road (east of Milwaukee Avenue).

This new station would **replace two aging stations on Saunders Rd. and Schelter Rd.**, improving response times, enhancing firefighter safety and increasing efficiency—without reducing staff levels.
